## **ASC Process for Yearly Goals**

- 1. At the first meeting of the academic year, ASC discusses ideas about yearly goals and creates a draft list of goals and priorities for the year
  - a. Review of past years' goals and accomplishments should inform this
- 2. At the second meeting of the academic year, ASC formally sets the yearly goals and priorities for the year
  - a. Minutes from this meeting are archived in Yearly ASC Goals academic senate folder
- 3. The ASC president works to move each of the goals forward throughout the year, acting as advocate and project manager to accomplish the goals
  - a. The priorities set by the ASC should influence the attention/energy spent on each goal by the ASC president
- 4. At either the last fall semester meeting or the first spring semester ASC meeting, the ASC president reviews progress on the yearly goals
- 5. At the final ASC meeting of the year, progress on goals is reported and next steps identified and recorded.
