



**☑** California Dream Act

If you are not a U.S. citizen or eligible non-citizen (including undocumented and DACA students) and meet AB540 requirements, you may qualify for state financial aid programs. Apply online by completing the California Dream Act Application, or CADA, at www.caldreamact.org. The deadline is March 2 annually for the following academic year.
