Resolution for Summer Decision-Making on behalf of the Academic Senate

Whereas, faculty are not required to work during the summer period between the end of the Spring semester and FLEX week prior to the start of the Fall semester, and the Academic Senate Council does not meet during that time; and

Whereas, the Academic Senate should always be involved in decisions related to academic and professional matters and the need for need to make such decisions in a time-sensitive manner occurs from time to time during this summer period; and

Whereas, the Academic Senate President and Academic Senate Vice President are elected by the full senate to represent faculty interests in academic and professional matters

Resolved that; ASC President should always be consulted by the college administration about decisions related to academic and professional matters, even during the summer period

Resolved that; for time-sensitive 10+1 decisions of low to moderate impact, the ASC president shall consult with the ASC Vice President to determine what decision or action would best serve faculty interests, to relay that decision to college administration, and to report on these actions at the first ASC meeting of the fall semester

Resolved that; for time-sensitive 10+1 decisions of moderate to high impact, the ASC president shall survey all ASC members to determine whether a special ASC meeting should be called to discuss, deliberate and decide about the issue, will call such a meeting if desired by the majority of ASC members responding within a reasonable period of time and will not call such a meeting if not desired and

Resolved that; if after reasonable efforts are made, an ASC meeting cannot be held or is not desired regarding a decision about a time-sensitive 10+1 issue of moderate to high impact, the ASC president shall consult with the ASC Vice President to determine what decision or action would best serve faculty interests, to relay that decision to college administration, and to report on these actions at the first ASC meeting of the fall semester
