COMMITTEE REPORTS

Faculty Development Committee Ellen Geringer reported that Foothill Community College received a grant for textbooks through <u>http://www.ccc.oer.org</u> in connection with Flat World Knowledge. Open educational resource books are used and can be downloaded for as low as 99 cents. Ted Wieden will schedule a time to come over to CCC and speak about this.

Ellen said that the first local Great Teacher Seminar will be in January. There will be 10-12 slots for CCC faculty, with newly tenured faculty having first availability. A visit to the Museum of Tolerance in Los Angeles is scheduled for next year. She said that Foundation money is available to full and part time faculty to create online courses. She distributed the CCC Foundation Funds Allocation for 2007-09 that included \$2800 for a week-long Local Great Teachers Seminar for faculty district-wide in January 2009; \$2500 for an on-campus speaker, Niccki Patton Rowe who speaks about brain-based training strategies; \$3900 for teaching-related conferences, where attendees must provide a flex workshop to share what they have learned. \$2000 for a Classroom Assessment Group (CAG) Facilitator stipend; \$13,800 for stipends to create online courses, for a total of \$25,000. Applications are available from Janie Franklin in the Staff Development Office or Staff Development website.

The Library is having their Book Sale Tuesday through Thursday. The retirement dinner for Gail Rodriquez, Lolita Adrien, and Ron Westin is June 16. There were no other committee reports available.
