


**CONTRA COSTA COLLEGE**

**Foreign Languages**

(Approved by the Contra Costa College Academic Senate Fall 2015)

The Foreign Languages Department recommends the following minimum qualifications for an equivalency:

1. A Bachelor's degree in the language being taught  
**and**  
A Master's degree in a related area (e.g. Latin American/Hispanic Studies, Bilingual Education, Linguistics, Applied Linguistics, Bilingual/Bicultural Studies) with a minimum of 15 graduate semester units in the language to be taught.  
**Or**
2. A Bachelor's degree in the language being taught  
**and**  
30 graduate semester units in a related area (e.g. Latin American/Hispanic Studies, Bilingual Education, Linguistics, Applied Linguistics, Bilingual/Bicultural Studies) with a minimum of 15 graduate semester units in the language to be taught.


