Masters or doctoral degree in economics, history, public administration,
public policy, social science, sociology, women's studies, any ethnic studies, or J.D.

AND

1. A Bachelor's degree in any discipline or field with the successful completion of at least 15 units of upper division or graduate course work in political science/politics, government, and/or international relations at an accredited post-secondary institution of higher education

OR

2. A Bachelor's degree in any discipline or field with the successful completion of at least 12 units of upper division or graduate course work in political science/politics/government/international relations at an accredited post-secondary institution of higher education







PLUS

at least six years of related, documented work experience (equivalent to three graduate units) defined as(*):

- Six years teaching in one or more of the following five subfields in political science (i.e. American politics, comparative politics, international relations, political theory, public and/or foreign policy) within an accredited post-secondary institution of higher education
- Six years relevant work experience in politics, law, and government, including but not limited to public office, public administration, campaigning, community organizing, and public advocacy law and social justice work.
- Or any combination of the two options above

(*): Two years of documented work and/or teaching experience equals one graduate unit.
