30 additional semester units of upper division or graduate course work (at least 15 units of which are graduate level), in psychology from an accredited institution.







Master's degree or doctoral degree in counseling, counseling psychology, clinical psychology, educational psychology, environmental psychology, human services psychology, experimental psychology, forensic psychology, health psychology, industrial/organizational psychology, neuropsychology/physiological psychology, school psychology, social psychology, sports psychology, human factors psychology, developmental psychology, marriage, family, and child counseling, marriage and family therapy, or social work

Five years of verifiable work experience as a private practice clinical psychologist or counselor or private practice social worker; five years of verifiable work experience as a counselor or social worker in a grade school, higher education institution, government social services agency, or a community-based social services agency; five years of verifiable work experience in student services as an administrator in a higher education institution; five years of verifiable work in social services as an administrator in a government social services agency or a community-based social services agency; or a combination there of (e.g., two years of verifiable work experience as a private practice counselor or private practice social worker and three years of verifiable work experience as a counselor or social worker in a grade school, higher education institution, government social services agency, or a community-based social services agency). The work experience can be paid or volunteer.
