AB288: College and Career Access Pathways Partnerships

- 1. Establishes a specific form for dual enrollment partnerships (College and Career Access Partnership) including:
 - a. Four primary goals of the CCAP Initiative
 - i. Expand DE for students who may not already be college bound or are underrepresented in higher education
 - To develop seamless pathways from HS to CC for CTE or preparation for Transfer
 - iii. Improving high school graduation rates
 - iv. Helping high school students achieve college and career readiness
 - **b.** Specific content elements that must be identified in the agreement # of HS students, FTES that will be claimed, courses to be offered, criteria to assess students readiness to enroll in courses.
 - **c.** Process for approving the agreement between districts approved by both boards, shared with public and open to public comment.
 - d. That it is filed with the State Chancellor's Office.
 - **e.** That it doesn't displace existing HS or CC instructors, complies with existing CBA's, and doesn't reduce or displace courses offered for adults.
- 2. Allows for closed courses only at high school campuses if offered during the regular HS instructional day.
- 3. Specifies students may take up to 15 units per term with qualifications no more than 4 courses, must be part of a program specified in the CCAP agreement, helps them attain both a high school degree and AA degree or credential,
- **4.** Provides specific language for when college faculty may teach remedial basic skills courses to high school students only for students assessed below skill level and as an innovative partnership between HS and college faculty.
- 5. Identifies additional annual reporting criteria for CCAP students and courses.
- Does not displace existing DE agreements already in place, but those agreements may not operate as a CCAP agreement (w closed courses, 15 units, etc) unless amended and filed with state CO.
