

Propose to add the following to the CCC Academic Senate By-laws:

“Article X, Section 10: Voting Procedures for Part-time Faculty

The term of office for Part-time faculty is two years. Part-Time Faculty At-Large Senators are elected by current faculty members holding part-time status at the time of the election. This representative can serve from any division at the college and must be actively employed as a part-time faculty member (either teaching a course or with other academic service) at the time of their election. Should a part-time faculty vacate the position prior to the end of a term, the Academic Senate Council shall appoint a part-time representative temporarily until the position can be filled permanently via a new election. The part time representative must vacate the position if they are not actively employed as a part-time faculty member for two semesters in a row. “
