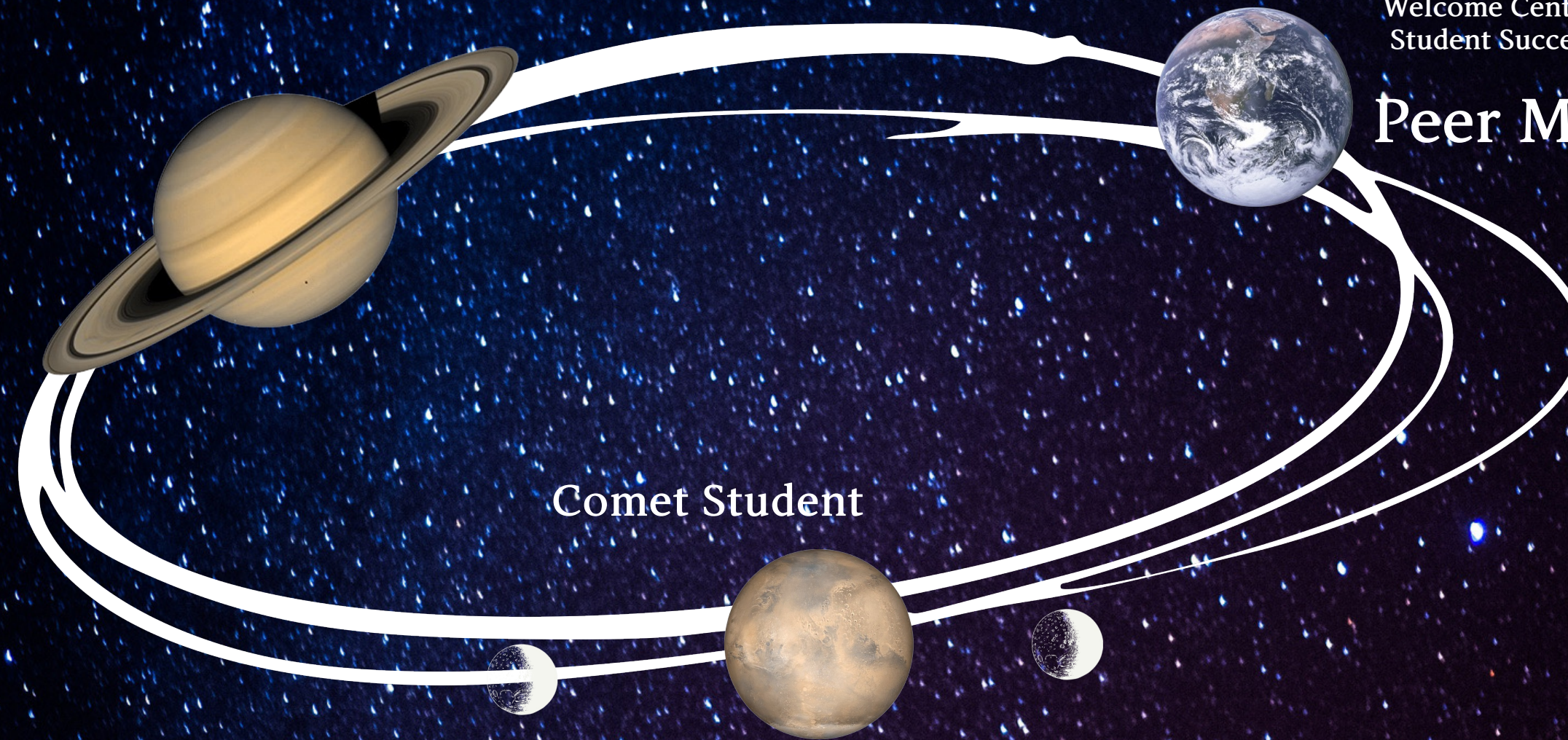

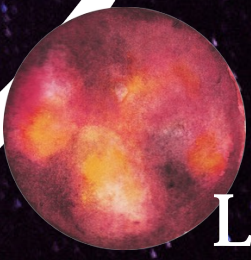

They could inform us of mandatory things

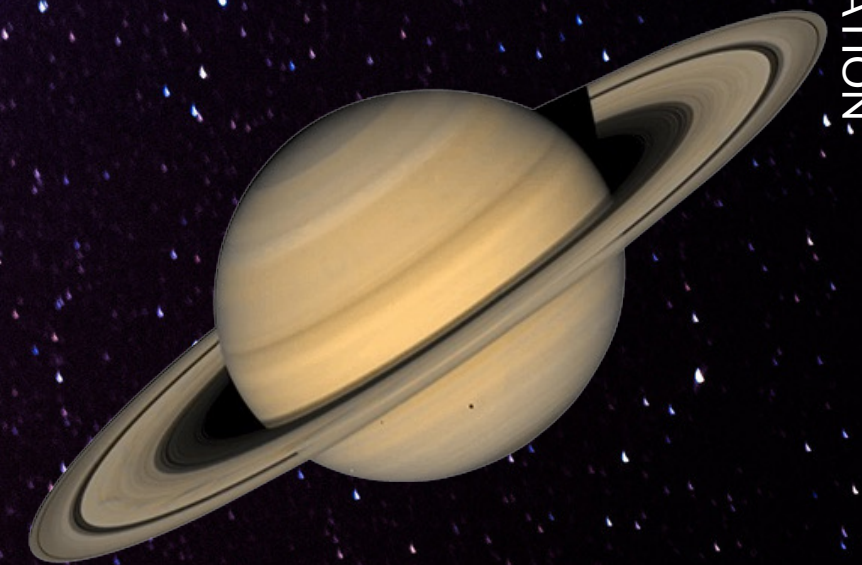
They could help us accessing the resources, the governing board, the transfer center, a play happening, events, look on a website.
