Goals

The CCC Chancellor's Office grant program would provide \$200,000 for 3 years to CCC for both individual faculty and departmental collaborations for the use of open educational resources (OER) and the creation of zero textbook cost (ZTC) certificates and degrees to address inequities associated with textbook costs. (There are also additional smaller departmental grants available. We are still waiting for more information from the CO on these funds.) This program is a college-wide initiative to:

- create complete ZTC degrees and certificates and advertise them to students,
- advance district and college equity goals, mitigate economic barriers to the success of minoritized students,
- close the success gap for Black, Latinx, Indigenous, and other students of color, and
- escalate enrollment and earn extra FTES.
