

Equivalency Statement for History:

Current Minimum Qualifications (January 2012):

Master's in history OR Bachelor's in history and Master's in political science, humanities, geography, area studies, women's studies, social science, or ethnic studies OR
The equivalent

1) A Bachelor's degree in History or political science, humanities, geography, area studies, women's studies, social science, ethnic studies, or folklore/cultural studies.

PLUS

2) 30 additional semester units of upper division and/or graduate-level coursework (at least 15 units of which are graduate level) in History.

OR

3) A combination of additional upper-division and/or graduate-level History coursework AND verifiable teaching experience in History at the college level, such that the combination equals a Master's degree.

The minimum combination is as follows:

A. 30 units of upper-division and/or graduate-level History courses, 15 units of which are graduate-level coursework in History


OR

B. 15 upper-division units in History and verifiable college-level classroom teaching experience in History with a minimum of 5 classes or 15 semester units

OR

C. 15 upper-division units in History and 5 scholarly books (or essays) published in History demonstrating expertise in the field.
