**Option 2**  
 Master's in African studies, Asian studies, Middle Eastern studies, and Latin American studies and the completion of at least 15 units of graduate work in sociology (or 12 units of graduate work in sociology and one published scholarly book dealing with culture or another aspect of sociology or 12 units of graduate work in sociology and two articles in a scholarly journal or scholarly conference proceedings dealing with culture or another aspect of sociology)
