- **We have 530,000 dollar Equity budget**
- **Usually the money is divided into sections but the state wants to bring all that money in to one big pot.**
- **OER is funded through Equity**
- **The main point of the Equity program is to help those of underrepresentation in college campuses by providing programs such as free bus passes and Free Breakfast.**
- **CCC has a low retention plan**
- **And the chances of Students making it to a transferable English or Math level is extremely low around 7-9 percent.**
- **The ASU board will note down a fee points to make sure that we have students have successful enrollment, Retention for students, transfer level for Math and Level, and Certificate for students.**

CCC Speech and Debate team
