Student Life Coordinator Salary

- The board last semester had to pay \$25,578 for the Student Life Coordinator salary position
- There has been roughly a \$2,000 increase for this semester.
- Dean Franco has been able to put aside \$12,500 to help pay for the position.
- As a rough approximation the board will now have to complete the remainder of \$15,000 for the Student Life Coordinator's salary.
