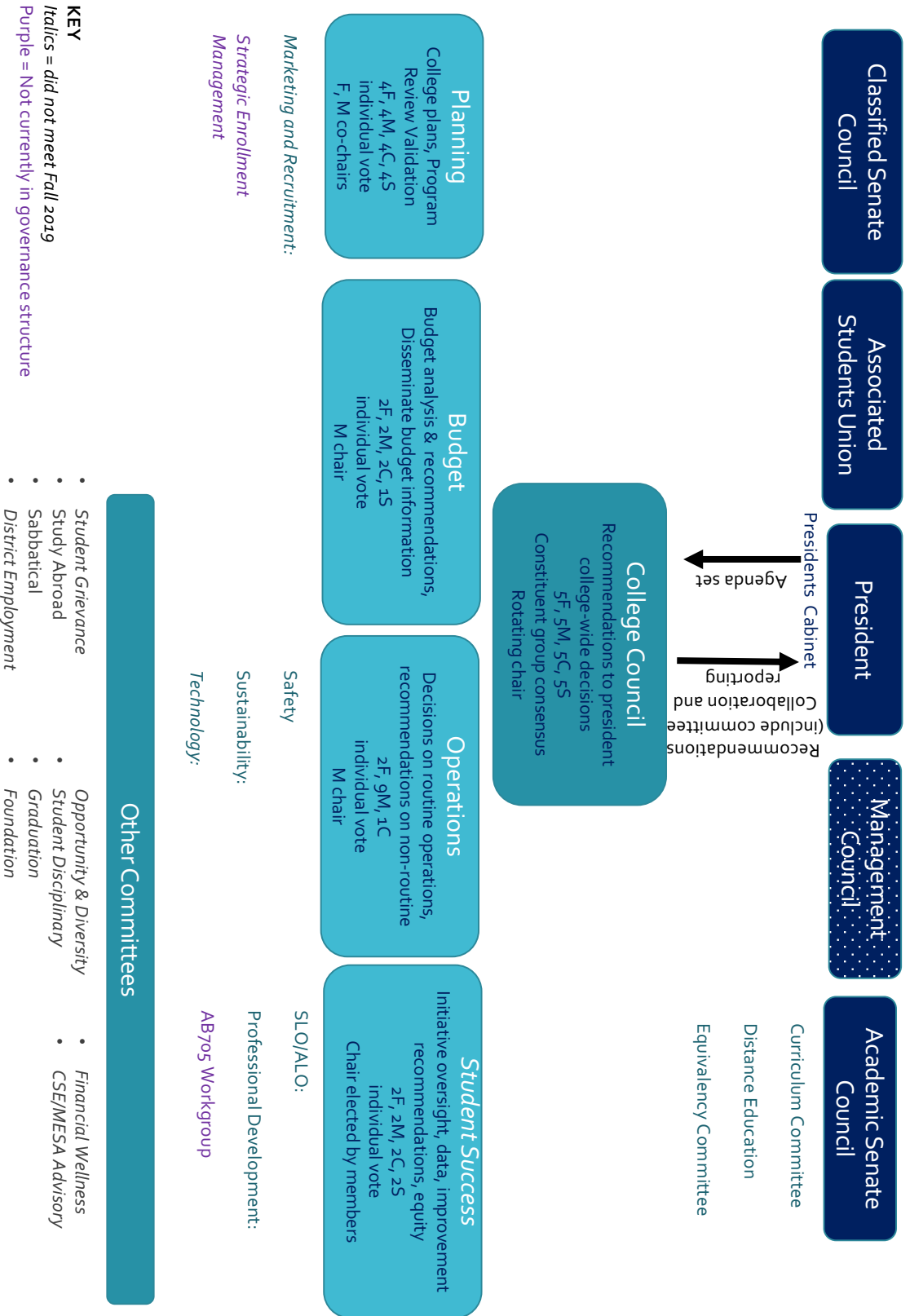
Records: Minutes are recorded and distributed to members and the public via the college website ([link](#)). Issues and actions are forwarded to the Student Success and Planning Committees.

- 5) Provide analysis of college-wide learning outcome assessment results and communication of global trends to improve student success.

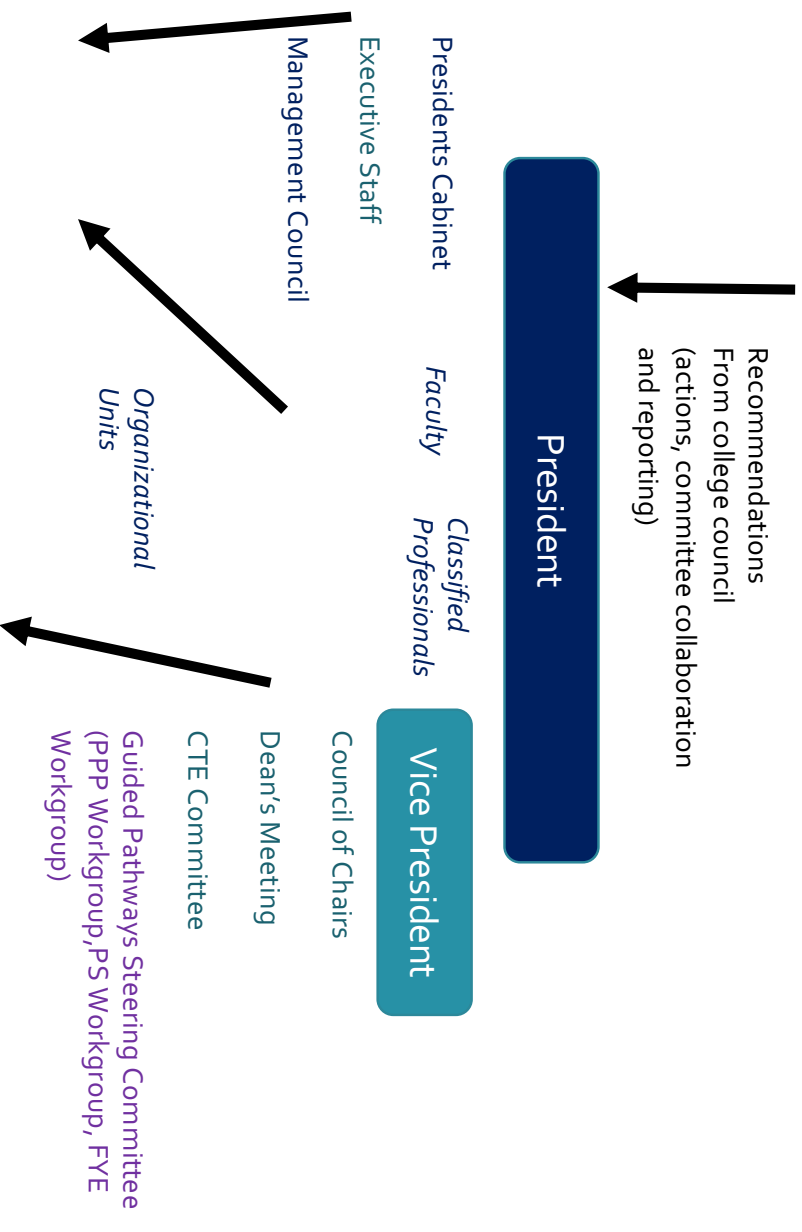

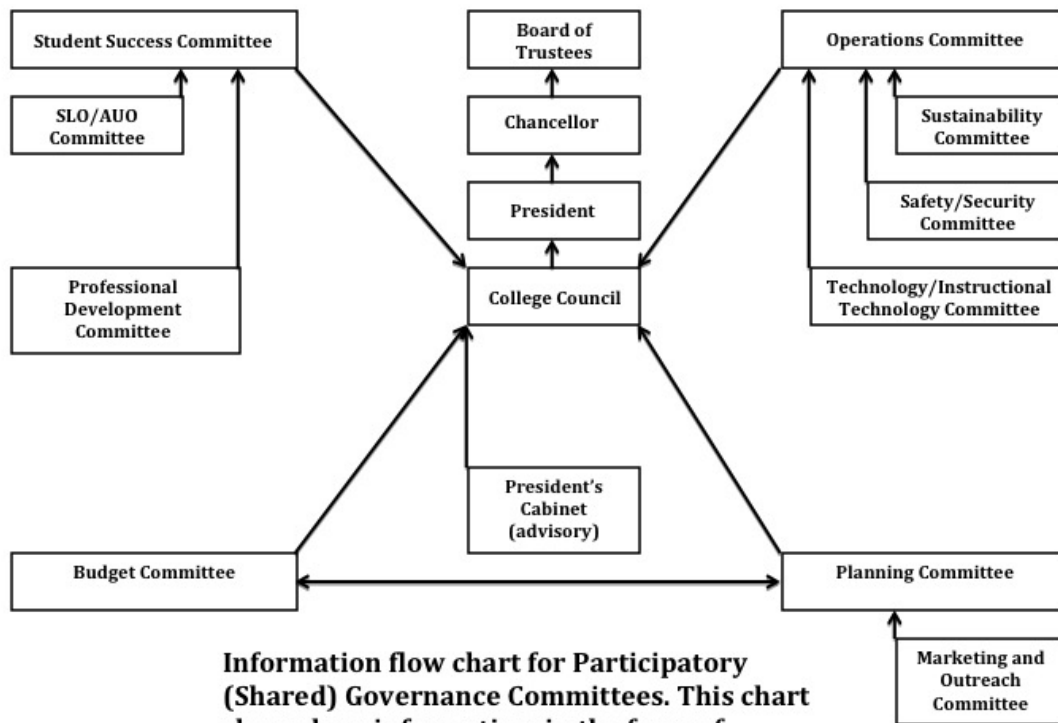

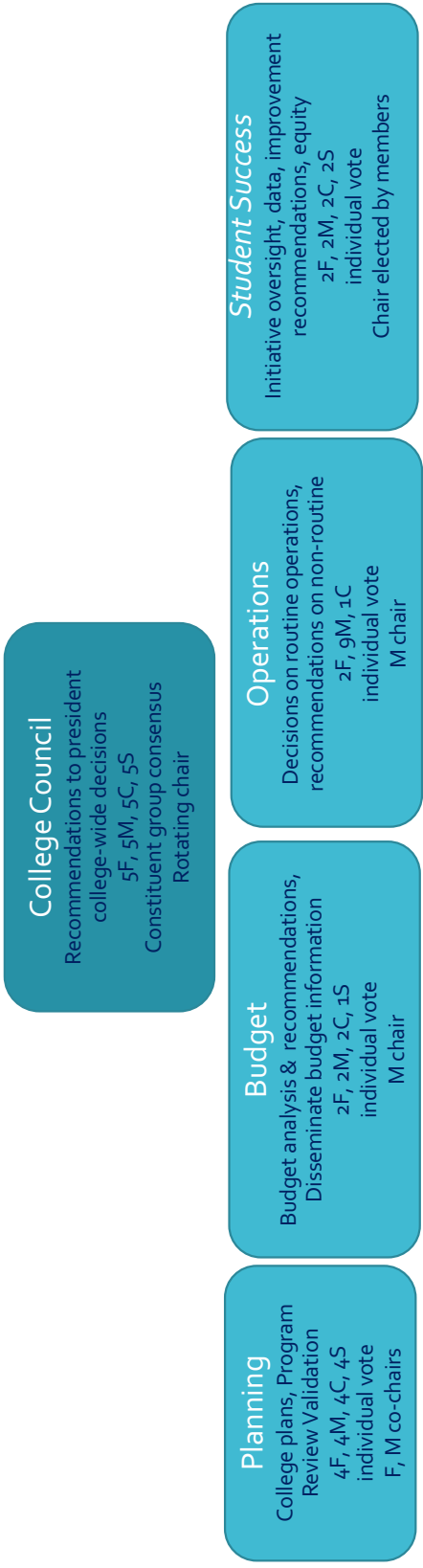
Management Structure: (Operationalize Decisions)
