Accreditation - Standard Four - Educational Programs (Williams) The provisions of this standard asks whether CCC's educational programs line up with its mission statement as far as our college curriculum; how it relates to the economics of our community; and, whether CC teaches to the needs of the population and demographics of our community. Mack was asked to send the last accreditation report along with the recommendations from the last accreditation to the CIC. CIC will be responsible for this area for Accreditation

GE Associate Degree (Williams) The general education requirements needs to be updated every so often. The issue discussed was that CCC doesn't receive degree credit when a student transfers to a university with the general education requirements without completing the AA degree. A Transfer Degree would give the college degree credit (which would help with PFE funds, and State money allocation for graduate degrees). CCC's Liberal Arts degree needs to be clarified. The CIC was asked to take this issue to their Divisions for feedback.
