Goehring was assigned A1 - A3. Area for research could be the catalog offerings of programs, mission statement vs. demographics of our community. Floyd was assigned A4, A5, D4. Areas for research could be Student Services, faculty listing, staff listing, campus map, Budget statement, Counseling, Matriculation, Academic Advisor. Duvall was assigned B2, B3, B4. Greene was assigned B5, B6, C1. Areas for research are Catalog (pgs. 59-60, CCC Breath requirements), AA/AS general education degree requirements, student records (passing with C or better), Voc Ed Certificates of Achievement/Completion. Diestler was assigned C2-C4. Areas for research are Title 5 guidelines (Ed Codes), Admissions, BP3007, page 39 of the CCC 1996 Accreditation Report, CIC documentation, copies of course outline and program. Elliott was assigned D1-D3. Areas for research are CIC manual, faculty evaluations, new course proposals, student evaluations and grades. Edmonds was assigned B1, D5, D6. Areas for research include Mission Statement vs. catalog program offerings, catalog, schedule, different modes of classes (lecture, lab, weekend college,

off-campus locations, TV, WEB, online), examples of Global English offerings, Distance Ed documentation. Rodriguez was assigned D7-D8. Areas for research are Global English documentation, Osaka agreement, and Contract Ed. Look at the last CCC report first, and the other accreditation reports from the other two colleges, checking to see if anything correlates, do new research and then write a short description, longer analysis, and a practical, realistic point of action. Save it in MS Word, on a disk, and send it to Jim Duvall, who will be compiling the new Standard Four.
