GENERAL AGENDA ITEMS FOR INFORMATION/DISCUSSION

DISTRICT-WIDE CURRICULUM COMMITTEE Jim attended this meeting and reported the following: DVC is dropping their Liberal Arts degree and changing their continuous ten-year enrollment to one-year. There was a proposal that any course can be taught at any of the three campuses regardless of who retains the rights. They approved a proposal that Academic Remedial be the same for all the campuses. Remediation by Grade Point Average (on page 47 of CCC catalog) states that up to 15 units of substandard grades can be removed from transcript, now will be replaced with an "R" (remedial), receives NC, and stays on the transcript. Priority Registration pilot for Fall semester will begin with priority given first to EOPS, DSPS, and highest

number of units completed. A proposal for Common Course Numbering system used throughout the district was discussed. Each campus would keep their own course numbering system but there would be a common number shared by the campuses. The district wants online courses created for an online AA/AS degree. The problem of the PE requirement could be satisfied by offering a PE theory course. The Waiting List on Web Advisor allows for students to sign up for the same course on MW and TTH which means two places are being held for one student. There should be a proposal to have a Distance Ed Coordinator hired to teach faculty about pod casting, etc. There is free source ware similar to WebCT available. No where does online courses tell the students what equipment, and skills, are required for an online course.
