REVIEW OF BROWN ACT

- Consent/Non-Consent Agenda Gabriela discussed using a consent/non-consent agenda in compliance with the Brown Act. Consent action items are issues that do not require prolonged discussion, if any at all. These would include items reviewed but not approved from the previous non-consent agenda. They would be returned after the issue was resolved. Other consent action items would include Content Reviews without prerequisites reviewed previously by the CIC Chair, the agenda, and minutes. The CIC members will receive the agenda and minutes to review prior to the meeting and be prepared to accept or request revisions to the documents. At that time, if members would like further discussion on a consent item, the item will be moved to the bottom of the non-consent section of the agenda. Non-consent action items are issues that need prolonged discussion. This issue will be returned to the next agenda for further discussion and approval of the process.
- **Distance Education Supplement Forms** The committee discussed the process of approval of these forms. Currently, the form is first approved by the Distance Education Coordinator and then appears as an agenda item to be recorded in the minutes. How much review is required by the CIC is questionable since it has already been approved by the Distance Education Coordinator. It is questionable whether these proposals are listed as a consent or non-consent action item on the future agendas. This issue will be returned to the next agenda for further discussion and approval of the process.
- **SLO Plans** The committee discussed the approval process for new and revised SLO plans. The feeling was that the plans and revisions should be extensively reviewed by the SLO Committee before being approved at the CIC. This issue will be returned to the next agenda for further discussion and approval of the process.
