ESL 135A, ESL 135B, ART 118, ART 190, ART 191, DRAMA 121 CURRICULUM TOPICS

- It was approved to discontinue the requirement of including the syllabus, test and assignment when new courses and Content Reviews are submitted; also, the course content no longer requires the percentages calculations on the outline. Syllabi are collected by the Division Officer, a section for sample assignments is included under the Outside of Class Assignments section of the course outline form.
- It was noted that November 11 is a holiday so the calendar will be corrected that agenda items for November 25 must be submitted by November 12.
- Kenyetta announced SB440 was signed by the governor this month. SB440, is critical follow up legislation to SB1440. It would require community colleges and the CSU to meet clear benchmarks for offering and accepting the new transfer degrees by 2015-16. In order to keep the promise of guaranteed admission to the CSU, the bill requires the CSU to develop an admissions redirection process for students who are not initially accepted to their campus of choice. The bill also calls for the development of areas of emphasis degrees in broader areas of study that provide community college students with more flexibility.
- This meeting will be Kenyetta's last before taking a new position at DVC. She said that the Academic Senate has announced the VP/CIC position and the new chair will be announced on October 21.
- Jason Berner will be chairing the last 3 CIC meetings for Fall 2013.
