Library Services - Considering OER during content review.

Andrew would like to get OER used more on campus. At one time, when new courses were proposed, he, as Library Coordinator, would meet with the faculty to make sure there were adequate resources in the library for the subject. His idea is that when new or revised courses are proposed, that there is an embedded link to OER for instructors to follow and see if there's any OER texts or materials appropriate for their class with a text box included that confirms that no appropriate materials were found, with a couple sentences written as to why not. With this, he feels that the faculty are at least reminded to seek out OER. Brianna asked where the links are to find the OER according to their subject. Andrew said that the link would be to the OER website but that the faculty would have to do a little research on the website to find OER available for their subjects. He knows that using OER is not required to use but at least it would be a reminder to try to find an online text to use. Andrew thought that maybe we can do something with professional development as an activity. Jason said we could encourage faculty to explore OER during content review. Anthony said the resources in OER aren't very good yet for a lot of the subject areas. Andrew would still like faculty to verify that they tried to find OER. Brianne asked if the OER resources are going to be updated occasionally. Andrew replied that he would look into that. Mark asked the members to think about this proposal and it will be brought back as a discussion item
