Discussion and vote: Consider new course COMP-152: Foundations in Data Science as possible emergency item. The APECS department shared several reasons why COMP-152 should be expedited as an emergency item: 1) Rising demand across colleges, 2) Rising UC Berkeley Enrollment, 3) An increase in community college data science growth, 4) DVC's waitlisted sections, and 5) Transfer opportunities, since the course was designed to be articulated with UC Berkeley.

The CIC committee decided that, while the reasons are compelling, they do not fall under the current emergency guidelines of having an immediate negative impact on students and COMP-152 should maintain its current position in the queue.
