# Discussion and vote:

1) Expedite MATH-191S to 11/25 agenda. Emergency category: AB1705.

This new course is being created to offer continuing support to students currently in MATH-190S. The department is requesting that this course be expedited to the 11/25 agenda in order to officially be offered in Fall 2025. The majority of committee members decided that this does not qualify as an emergency because AB1705 mandates do not extend to MATH 191 since students do not place directly into it. Students who successfully complete MATH-190 and 190S should be sufficiently prepared to succeed in MATH-191 without the support course.

2) Expedite LARAZ-130 and LARAZ-190 to 11/25 agenda. Emergency category: Articulation, severe student impact. Both courses are at risk of losing Ethnic Studies GE articulation, despite being revised and submitted multiple times, and must be resubmitted with the most recent updates. The committee unanimously voted to expedite both courses to the 11/25 agenda.
