Programs have been switched to online including ergonomic evaluations for at home and in-office work stations. For ergonomic evaluations, employee must get approval from manager. The website has numerous healthy habits worksheets, on demand videos and access to relaxation/meditation apps. CALM APP is free to Kaiser members and discounted for educators. Fit testing for masks are also available. There is no official word to require school employees to get the COVID-19 vaccine.
