Review of Institutional Learning Outcomes:	What we have learned and what we need to work on
The current 17 CCC Institutional Learning Outcomes are based upon the IGETC standard, which is not pertinent to many programs, particularly in non-transfer and administrative area. The previous 8 ILOs were still fairly program specific. Most other colleges have fewer, simpler outcomes. Based upon the terms community and the subgroups of education, an interpreted set of ILOs would be: Provide and encourage the members of our community to gain: Practicle knowledge through abilities, information, and judgement; Communication skills using verbal, auditory, written, and visual forms; and Awareness of themselves, their community, and the world about them.
