- 1. There is nothing new to report regarding key inventory. Still in the process of collecting data.
- 2. Evacuation/shelter-in-place/lockdown drill has been postponed due to finals and rainy weather. It will resume first week of February. Jose attended a training at the District office regarding the emergency texting and email system. - 4. Bruce reported on the ongoing Facilities/Construction projects:
 - New College Center –During the winter break the power will be shut down on December 29 and 30, 2014 for about 4 to 5 hours and it will be turned back on in the late evening or early afternoon.
 - Parking Lot 16 This is scheduled to be finished on December 18, 2014 and it is anticipated to be opened March or April of 2015.
- 5. Other Business:
 - Darlene informed everyone of a problem she's been having with homeless people coming into the buildings. She said she has no way of knowing if they are students or not and it's becoming a problem. They are using the building to stay out of the cold and keep warm.
 - Jose reported that staffing for police services has been a challenge due to staff on vacation and illness. Unfortunately other facilities have shortage

as well so they can't borrow staff from them. Police services is actively looking to hire new staff and are looking for student workers as well.

- There will be minimum staffing for Police Services during the winter break. Only one staff District wide so if an emergency comes up during the winter break, Jose suggest to contact "911" for immediate assistance.
