	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The need for the ASU Sustainability Committee to help host locations for the Bike-to-Birthday event in May.</li> <li>• Recycling collection efforts, noting custodians are currently fulfilling campus facilities assistant duties.</li> <li>• Continued issues with contaminated recycling bins.</li> </ul> <p>Robert also reported that the MCHS trash, recycling, and composting program has relocated to the AA Building and will soon relaunch with expanded educational materials for staff and students.</p> <hr/> <p><b>Electric Vehicle Charging Stations Update – Robert Bagany</b></p> <p>Robert reported that approximately five EV charging stations are currently disabled due to vandalized cables. The committee discussed replacing damaged units and installing more secure, cut-resistant cables. While cut-resistant technology is available, recently introduced models may not meet immediate needs. It was clarified that all parts of the stations are replaceable, making repair less extensive than full station replacement.</p>
